

Policy 17 – Conveyance of Students

• Eligibility Criteria:

- Elem/Middle walk limits
 - 3.2 km to nearest school
- Secondary walk limits
 - 4.0 km to nearest school
- Consideration for hazardous crossings
- Students with special needs
- Students force transferred from catchment school
- Out of catchment/district programs (fee applies)








Last Transportation Review

2016 Review:

- Distance Analysis:
 - Many students live within walk limits
 - Students in district programs tend to live further



Ministry Funding Information

Ministry Funding for Transportation

- Funded by the Ministry until 2001-02 (\$2.13M)
- 2002-03 *School Act* changes:
 - Eliminated requirement to provide student transportation
 - Eliminated references to student walk limits
- Funding from 2002-03 to 2009-10 was frozen at \$1.95M
- 2012-13 Elimination of Funding → Student Location Factor
- In 2016 the Ministry Transportation grant eliminated fees charged to parents for in-catchment student transportation only. (approx. \$313,000)
- New funding model **does not** provide Ministry funding for student transportation

Last Transportation Review

Transportation Review:

- Budget in 2016-17
 - Increased fees generated \$200,000

Transportation Fee Schedule	2015-16	2016-17
In catchment - Inside walk limits	\$300/\$500	\$400/\$600
District Programs	\$300/\$500	\$600/\$800

• Improved efficiencies (routes re-design) reduced expenses by \$200,000







Transportation Issues

Issues

- Net financial loss in transportation negatively impacts the budget.
- Increasing demand from parents & schools exceeds our current capacity.
- Schools have identified curricular & extra-curricular busing as a significant issue.
- Recruitment of bus drivers has become increasingly difficult.
- New funding model creates budget uncertainty.
